Community Roots Market

Where you will find “ALL Things LOCAL”

Please consider vending at Community Roots Market. Our market will be on every Sunday starting June 14th, from 11am to 4pm. As a LOCAL Producer you are very important to the vitality of our community. Our goal is to promote a BUY LOCAL atmosphere that celebrates the farmers, musicians, artisans & crafters that enrich our community.

We boost our local economy every time we buy something we need from a local source.

A recent study found that for every \$100 spent at a conventional grocery store only \$25 goes back into the local economy. For every \$100 spent at a local market \$62 goes back into the local economy and \$99 out of the \$100 stays in the state! This event will help you sell local and keep our money in our community.

The fee to set up and vend is \$5 for every \$100 you sell. You will pay \$5 when you get to the market. The market coordinator will then check back in with you before you leave to see if you have sold over \$100. Vendors may arrive at 10am to start setting up to be ready by 10:30. You may unload in the alley. Please park on the streets, not in the parking lots. Our market is an indoor/outdoor market. You may want to bring a canopy if you plan on setting up outside. You will need to bring everything for your display including tables. We do have some chairs on site if that is helpful. We have few spots that have access to electricity and these are first come first serve. We do have water and bathrooms on site, along with live LOCAL music.

To vend at Community Roots Market the items being sold must be made or grown within 200 miles of Spokane. We do not allow toxic products such as body care items made with fragrance oils; essential oils are fine. We encourage back yard gardens along with local farmers to set up. We also encourage you to barter with market vendors and attendees.

We will be installing a credit card machine, a food stamp machine and applying to take WIC farmers market vouchers, so that folks who want to buy from you will be able to pay using debit/credit/food stamp cards.
